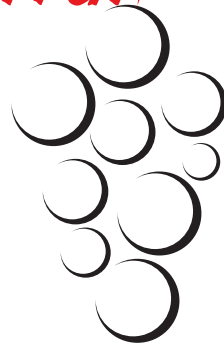

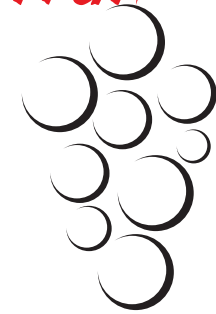

"Pea-no-Nwahr"

14th century Roman records indicate Pinot Noir is the world's oldest, continually used grape variety.

It is a thin skinned variety grown in cool climate locations, with low tannins and a medium body and flavors of earth, smoke and cherry.

Pinot Noir goes well with beef, lamb, pork and poultry .

Pinot Chardonnay
"Pea-no-Char-don-nay"

Chardonnay was once known as Pinot Chardonnay and its genetic history is related to the Pinot family.



Pinot Gris
"Pea-no-Gree"

A descendent of Pinot Noir , the grape is pink skinned but produces a white wine.

Very versatile, reflecting the winemaker's creativity in dry and off dry styles.

Bright and citrusy with aromas of green apple and delicate herbals.

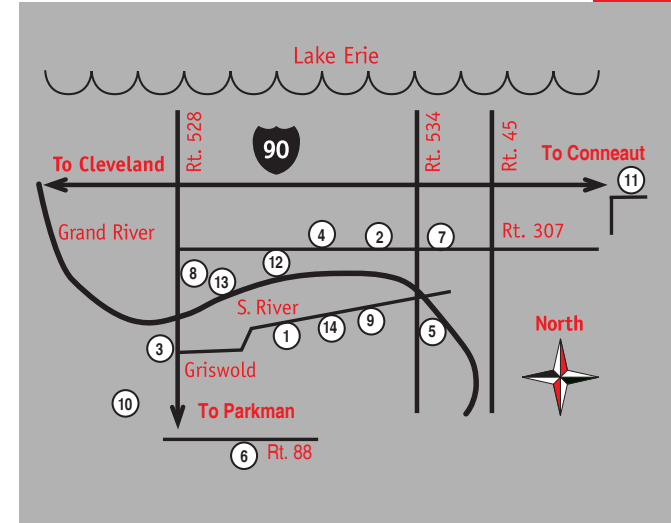
